Unless otherwise noted, passing test scores are 3, 4, or 5. Please note: Certain other non-course credits, including International Baccalaureate and GCE Level-A's, may also be used in this way. Note that if the student takes a course for which AP credit has already been given, duplicated units may be deducted.
