

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) CREDIT

Passing scores on certain CEEB Advanced Placement (AP) Tests taken prior to admission to the College of Environmental Design may be used to satisfy specific college prerequisites as shown in the AP EXAM TABLE below. Unless otherwise noted, passing test scores are 3, 4 or 5. Please note: Certain other non-course credits, including international Baccalaureate and GCE Level-A's, may also be used in this way. For specific information, please consult the Office of Undergraduate Admissions (642-3175) or Foreign Admissions (642-3246).

AP credit earned prior to entering the college shall not be counted toward maximum unit limitations, either for the selection of a major or for graduation, unless the student so desires. Also, please note that if the student takes a course for which AP credit has already been given, duplicated units may be deducted by the college.
