THE FOLLOWING SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE TO UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS IN THE COLLEGE OF ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN.

Award decisions for most scholarships are based on GPA with preference given to those with financial need. Preference is also given to those who will be juniors or seniors in the Fall Semester in which the awards are made---and those with a GPA of 3.3 or greater. It is strongly recommended that students have applied for financial aid by filling out the FAFSA form available from the Undergraduate Financial Aid Office. Students with excellent GPAs, but no financial need may be awarded honorary scholarships usually around \$1,000.

Class of 24 Scholarship -- \$9,500 (2 awards last year)

Must be an undergraduate architecture major.

Camille J. Ehrenfels Scholarship -- \$5,500 (2 awards last year)

Awarded to 1 female and 1 male of junior standing. Preference given to architecture students.

Lee F. Fallman Scholarship -- \$4,000 (4 award last year)

Must be an undergraduate architecture major.

Fong & Chan Architects Scholarship -- \$15,000 (3 awards last year)

Based on academic record and financial need. Must be an undergraduate architecture major.

Willard Franke Student Support Fund -- \$1,500 (1 award last year)

Based on academic record and financial need. Must be an undergraduate architecture major.

Gadsby-Trudgett Scholarship -- \$2,000-\$9,000 (2 award last year)

Given to seniors in the College of Environmental Design who show evidence of broad interest in environmental design. Requires two letters of recommendation and a personal statement. Must have a 3.3 GPA or above.

Kenneth Kurtzman Memorial Scholarship -- \$1,500 (1 award last year)

For architecture majors with a junior or senior standing and minimum 3.0-3.5 GPA. Based on an excellent academic record and financial need.

Rosanna E. Luis Scholarship -- \$2,000 (1 award last year)

Must be an undergraduate architecture major.

Walter Moody Scholarship -- \$3,500 (1 award last year)

Based on academic record and financial need. Must be an undergraduate architecture major.

Kenneth Foster Strong Memorial Scholarship-- \$7,000 (3 awards last year)

Must be an undergraduate architecture major.
